- bad air



Other advantages of living in a city

- 2. Availability of theaters, museums, concert halls, art galleries, etc. for broad exposure to culture.
- 3. Opportunities for higher education and continuing education.



- 4. Variety of entertainment - restaurants, sporting events, night life, parks.
- 5. Public transportation that does not pollute very much and that saves energy.
- 6. Many of the best private schools are located in big cities.
- 7. Shopping.



Other disadvantages of living in a city

- 3. Little or limited access to outdoor activities (hunting, camping, skiing).





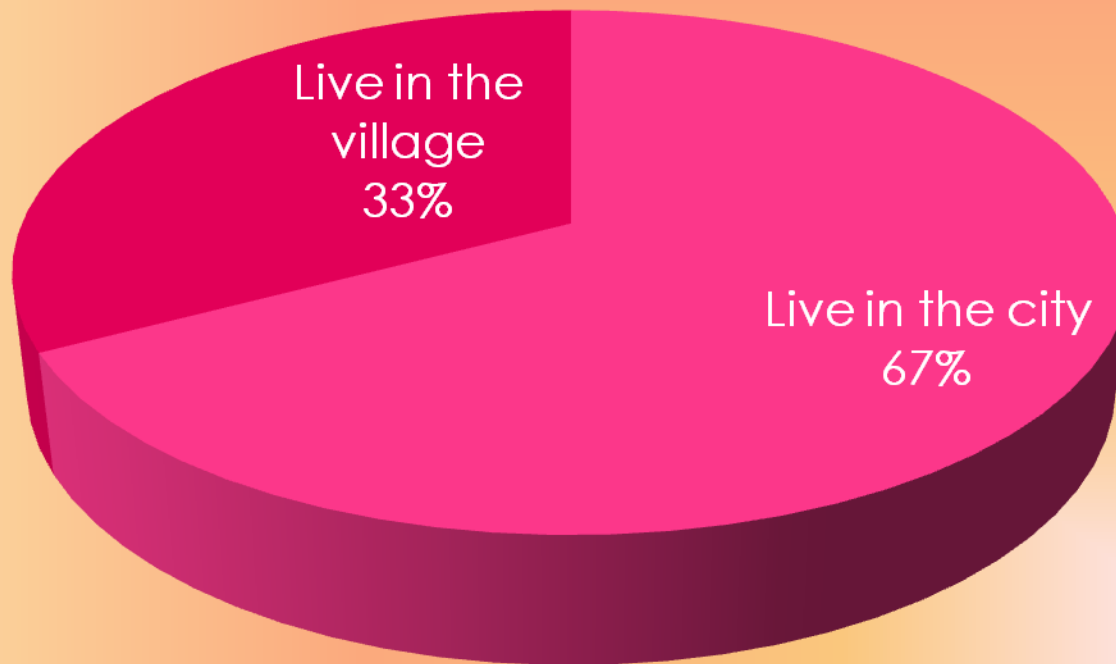
- 4. The cost of living in large cities is often very high.

- Moreover, there aren't such interesting things to do during free time. The unemployment rate is also much higher than in the city.



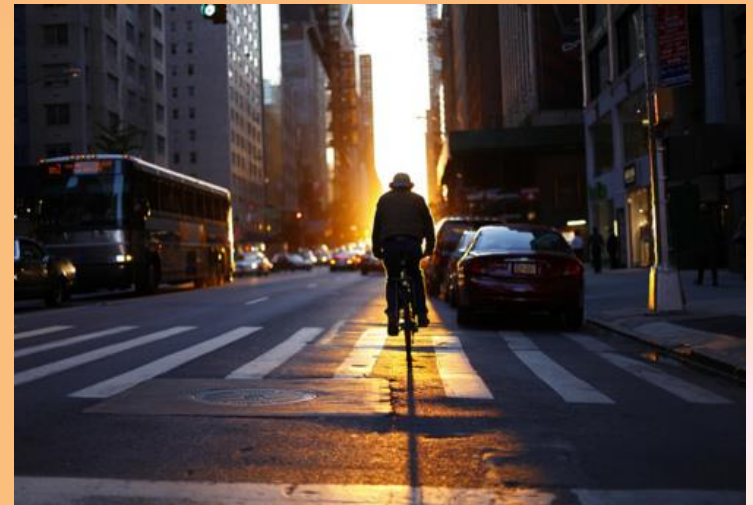
The advantages and disadvantages of living in the country

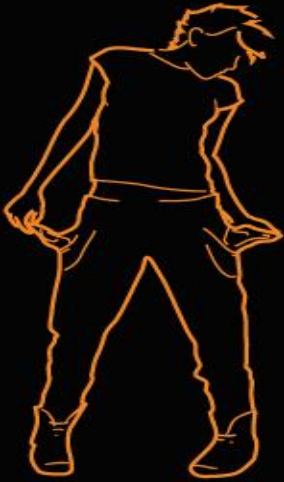

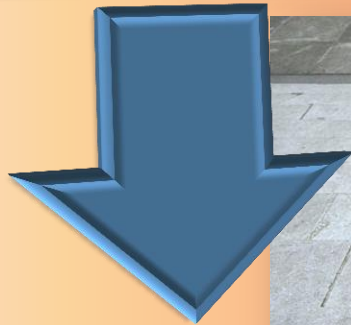

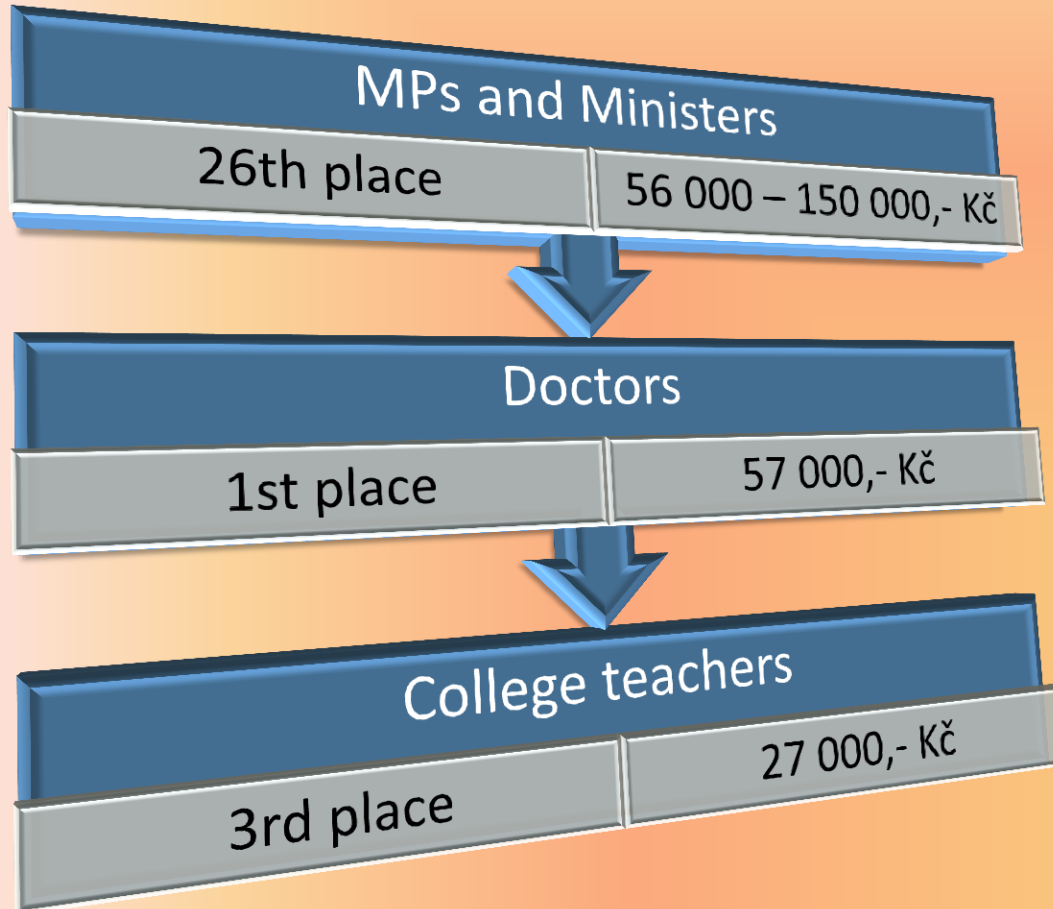

- But MP? How is it possible, that MP is the least prestigious job? – When MP takes one of the biggest salary in our country?



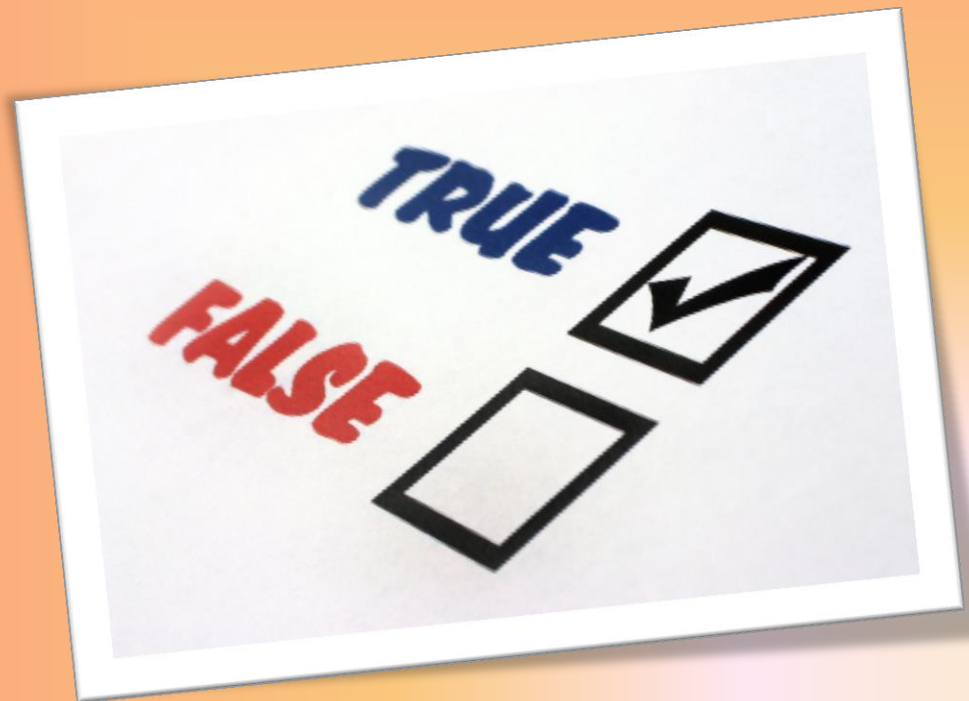
Salaries of recognised professions are often lower.

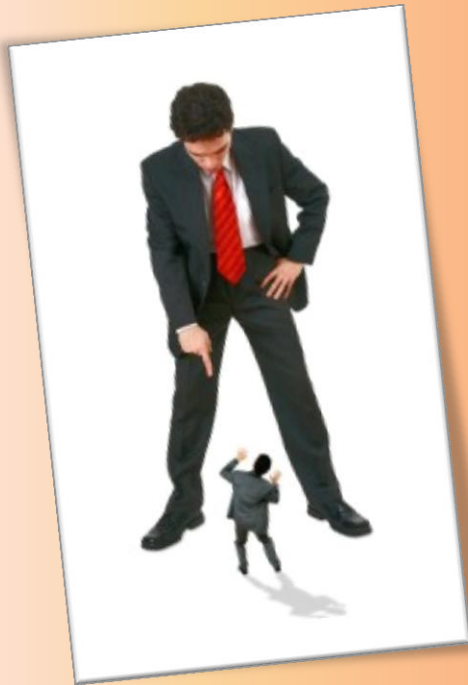

1. economic crisis

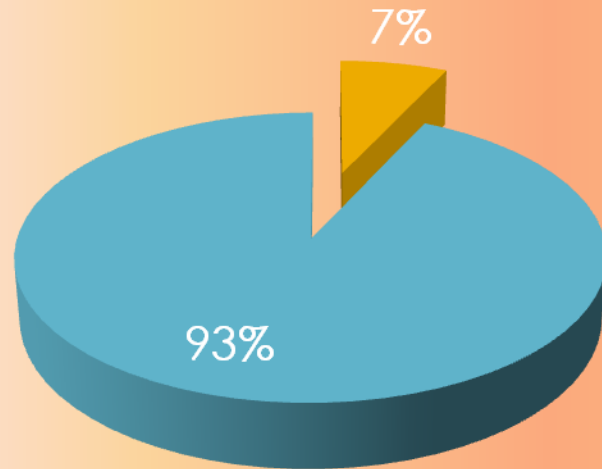
2. growing unemployment

Satisfaction with work in Czech republic

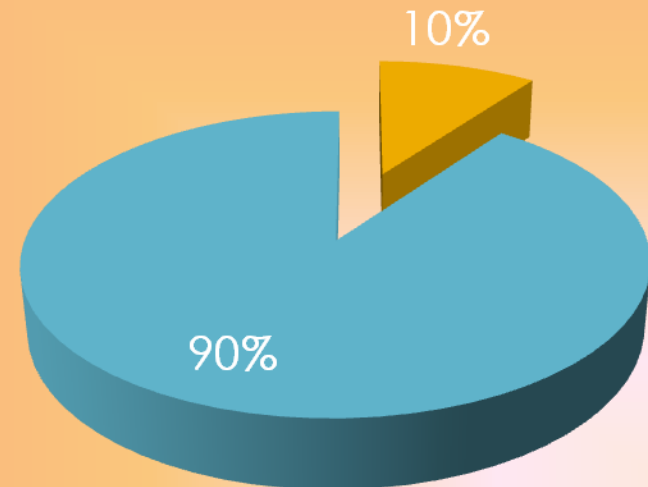
How people are satisfied with their work

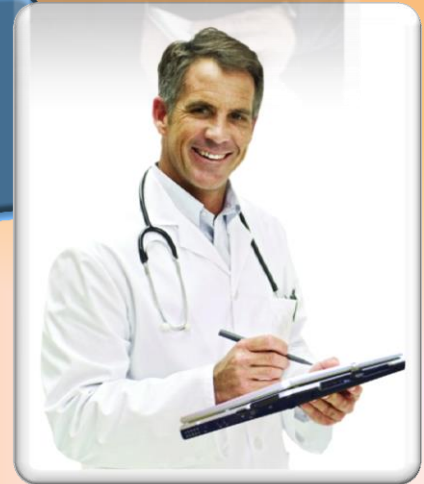

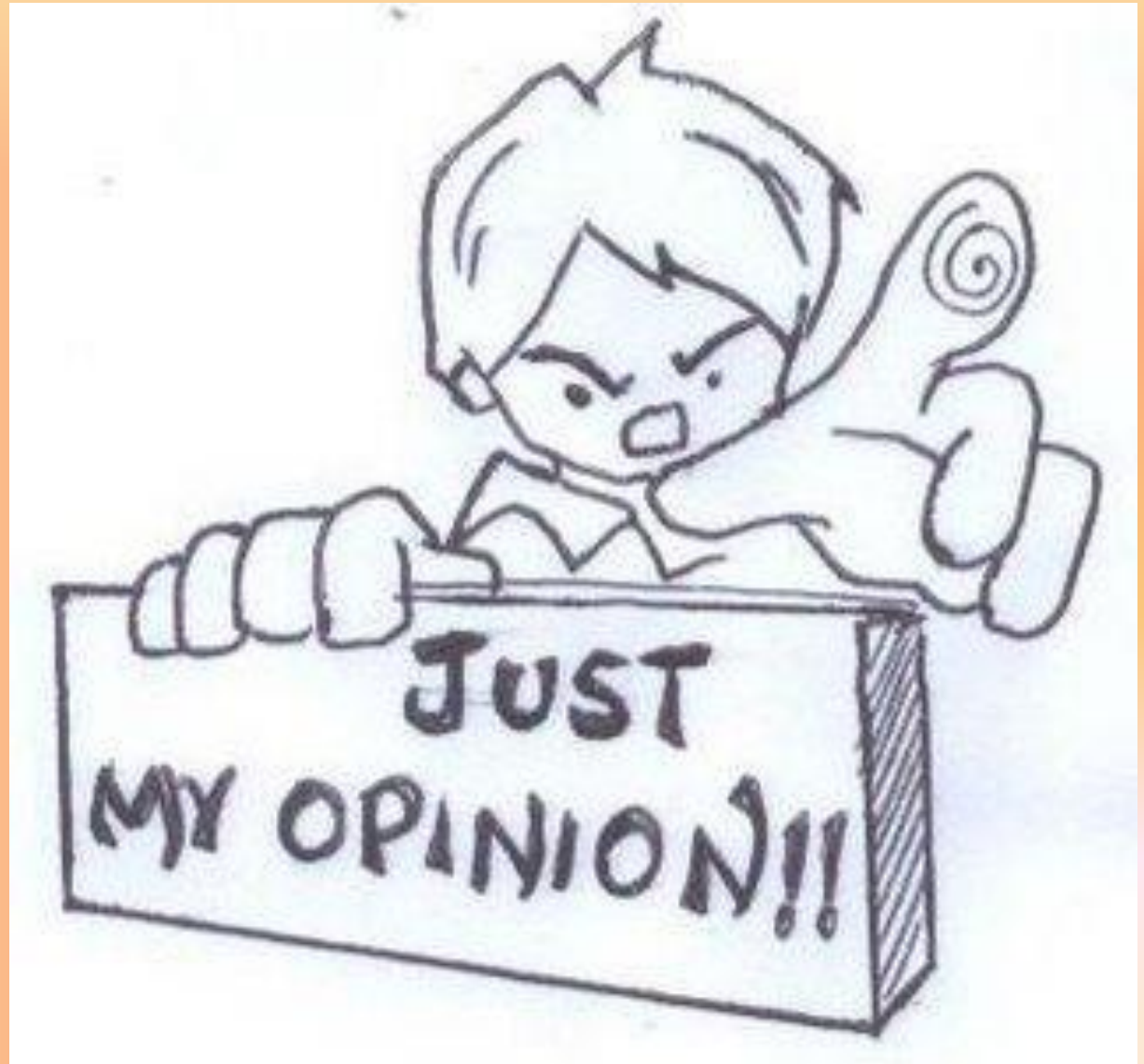

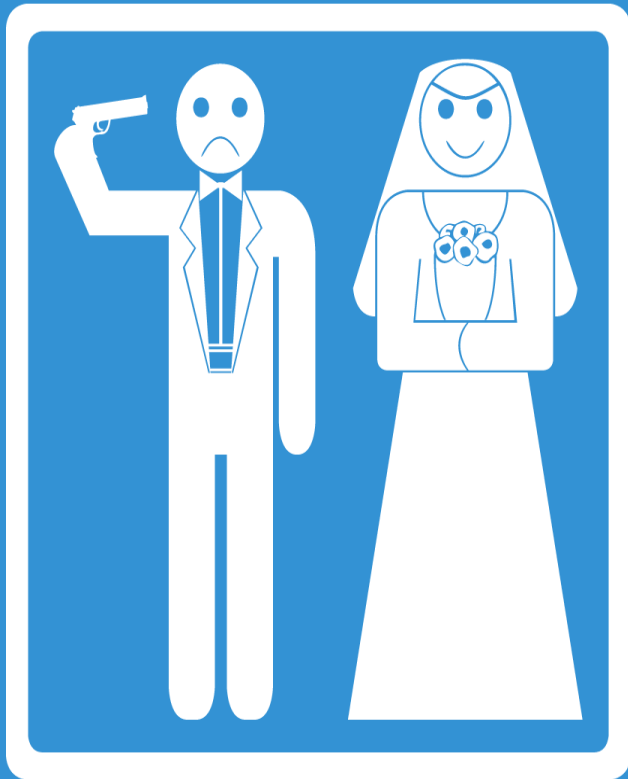
