## Information for candidates / Candidate Consent Form

Priority remark deadline: 14<sup>th</sup> August preferred, 21st August absolute – only for students waiting for a university place. Clerical check deadline: 18<sup>th</sup> September – Checks all pages are marked, checks adding up ONLY. Standard remark deadline: 18<sup>th</sup> September – Most common remark request – a full remark.

The following information explains what may happen following an enquiry about the result and any subsequent appeal of an examination.

If your examination centre makes an enquiry about the result and a subsequent appeal of one of your examinations after you subject grade has been issued there are three possible outcomes:

- Your original mark is lowered, so your final grade may be lower than the original grade you received.
- Your original mark is confirmed as correct, there is no change to your original grade
- Your original mark is raised, so your final grade may be higher than the original grade you received.

In order to proceed with the enquiry about results, you must sign the form below. This tells the school that you have understood what the outcome might be, and that you give your consent to the enquiry about results being made.
