Dear Parent / Carer

You will be aware that a hoody, worn as an outer garment, does not conform to the school's policy on uniform. The only exception to this is when a student is wearing a school sports top, issued by the PE department, and they are travelling to or from a sports fixture. Detailed guidance on uniform can be found on page 6 of the Student Planner.

As there currently appears to be a growing problem with students who feel that wearing a hoody to school is acceptable, we will be taking the following action immediately after the February half term break. If your son or daughter arrives on campus wearing a hoody it will be confiscated. The hoody will be sent to the main office where it will be stored securely. You will then be sent a letter asking you to contact the school and arrange a time to collect the hoody from reception. Any hoody which remains uncollected after a period of three weeks will be sent to a local charity shop.

Students who continue to ignore this rule on uniform will be disciplined in line with agreed Positive Discipline sanctions. Clearly we want to avoid taking this action and therefore ask for your support in ensuring that your child comes to school correctly dressed.
