Content to include:

- Health conditions: Arthritis, cardiovascular conditions, coronary heart disease, cerebral vascular accident, diabetes (type 2), dementia, obesity, respiratory conditions, asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), additional needs, sensory impairments, physical impairments, learning disability
- Health services available: primary care, secondary care, tertiary care, allied health professions
- Social care services: social care, domiciliary care, informal care, voluntary care
- Definition of barriers: something unique to the health and social care system that prevents an individual to access a service.
- Types of barrier: physical barriers, sensory barriers, social barriers, cultural barriers, language barriers, geographical barriers, text barriers, financial barriers and how they can be overcome by the service providers or users.
