Percentage of students who achieved a grade 4 or above in English and Maths 84% (83%)

(this figure is the closest comparison to old style A-C)*

Percentage of students who achieved a grade 5 or above in English and Maths 66% (59%)

Average Attainment 8 grade 5.8 (5.47)

EBacc average grade 5.4 (5.14)

Progress - Due to the way it is calculated the 2022 'Progress 8' figure will not be available until later in this academic year. In 2019 the Progress 8* figure was: 0.3

*Progress 8 is a measure of progress used by all schools since 2016. The 0.3 figure is above the national average of 0.0. A figure of 1.0 would mean students at that school achieved a full grade higher on average than they would
