

As you will see from the attached letter, the number of positive cases of COVID-19 has remained consistently low this week. In light of this significant reduction in cases, the additional measures currently in place will be removed from **Monday 22nd November**. This is in line with the school's Risk Assessment and Outbreak Management Plan.

This means that **face coverings will no longer be required** on corridors / in communal areas. We will, instead, revert to the policy which was in place at the start of this school year. In other words:

- Students **must** wear a face covering when travelling to school on public transport or dedicated school transport
- Students and staff **may choose** to wear a face covering when:
  - Moving around the school, such as on corridors
  - In enclosed and crowded communal areas, such as waiting outside of classrooms, in the dining area or in assembly

Finally, a reminder that next Friday (26th November) is a Training Day when school will be closed to all students.
