## Year 11 Core Subject Trial Examinations

On the second page of this letter you will find a copy of the Year 11 **Core Subject** Trial Examination Timetable. This can also be viewed on the school website and is available in school on the exam noticeboard.

Students will complete these additional trial examinations in **English**, **Maths and Science** only. As most subject content will have been covered the papers will closely replicate those taken in the final summer examinations. This will give students valuable practice on timings for a full exam paper and the core faculties additional information which they can use to help students achieve their best in the summer exams.

The exams run over the fortnight from **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February until Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> February** taking place in classrooms almost exclusively *within the regular timetabled lessons for these core subjects*. When students do not have an examination, they will follow their normal timetable. The period, date and length of each examination is clearly shown on the timetable overleaf.

Students should take these examinations seriously and prepare well for them; your support with this is appreciated. In the unlikely event that public exams are cancelled in Summer 2024, information from these assessments (along with previous and future work) will be utilised to ensure appropriate grades are awarded to students.

Students are expected to write in black ink and must bring all the necessary equipment for the examinations, including, but not limited to: calculator, ruler, spare pens and pencils. Students should liaise with their class teachers regarding what each exam entails and any preparation/ revision that should be completed. Short, concentrated periods of revision are best and students are advised to prepare a revision timetable and keep to it.

If there are any questions regarding these exams students should contact their class teacher.
