Non-uniform Day – Thursday 28th March 2024

In response to a request from our Senior Students, we have agreed to hold a non-uniform day next week on Thursday 28th March, which is the last day of this term. Non-uniform day enables all students to show their support for their chosen charities, which for 2023-2024 are Parkinson's UK (selected by the Student Council) and local charity Hug On a Tray, which supports Haematology patients and families at St James's Hospital, Leeds (chosen by Year 7 students).

We are recommending that students wishing to take part in non-uniform day make a contribution of **£2.00**. This can either be made using the online payment system or through a cash donation which will be collected during registration on Thursday morning.

For clarity, fancy dress is not permitted on this day, and students still need to bring PE kit, if appropriate. Students also need to consider any health and safety implications in terms of what they choose to wear, especially if they have practical subjects on this day. Please note that the usual school rules regarding hair styles apply as normal.
