



Recognition of prior learning

Prince Henry's Grammar School Swim England Qualifications Centre actively encourages the recognition of prior learning (RPL) as an assessment method for Swim England qualifications, following guidelines supplied by the Swim England Qualifications Awarding Body. Prior learning is to be accurately assessed and used to inform effective assessment decision-making. Initial assessment at the time of enrolment will identify prior learning.

Template procedure

1. All staff at Prince Henry's Grammar School Swim England Qualifications Centre will receive training on the RPL including the identification and evaluation of this and how it may be effectively used. This will be supported by written reference in the staff handbook.
2. Prince Henry's Grammar School Swim England Qualifications Centre will carry out appropriate initial assessment of all learners at the point of enrolment to identify potential RPL. This will be verified by confirming details of RPL with the candidate and the assessor assigned to that learner.
3. The assessor will assess the relevant RPL and complete appropriate documentation to accurately record this.
4. IV will sample RPL assessment decisions using the initial assessment documentation and those completed by the assessor to verify this.
5. RPL assessments will be reported to the Prince Henry's Grammar School Swim England Qualifications Centre AB in the appropriate manner.

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
