Within the guidelines of social distancing, Otley Courthouse has a team of volunteers who are willing to go shopping, visit the post office and do other various errands for those who are remaining at home as a result of COVID-19.

The telephone will be staffed between 10am – 4pm Monday to Friday. An answerphone service is available for those who phone outside office hours and you will be contacted the following day.
