Join us at the barricades of freedom! It's time to get your tickets for our fabulous production of ***Les Misérables – School Edition***, a musical by Alain Boublil and Claude-Michel Schönberg.

A cast from across the school will be performing the show and our specially created show band will accompany them. One of the world's most iconic and longest-running musicals, *Les Misérables* tells the story of Jean Valjean. Victor Hugo's classic tale is an enthralling story of broken dreams and unrequited love, passion, sacrifice and redemption – a timeless testament to the survival of the human spirit. With a magnificent score of iconic songs including "*I Dreamed a Dream*", "*On My Own*", "*Bring Him Home*", "*One Day More*" and more, this epic and uplifting story is undisputedly one of the world's favourite musicals.

Tickets cost just £10 for adults and £6 for concessions and children and are available from the desk by Student Reception at break and lunchtime or from School Reception from Monday 13 January 2025. I am pleased to confirm that school can provide a 50% subsidy on student tickets for students in Years 7 to 11 who are currently in receipt of free school meals. If applicable, please mention 'FSM' when buying tickets. The production is entirely funded by ticket sales, so do come along and enjoy the show.

There will be reserved seating again this year, so get your tickets early and make sure you get the seats you want! Send a note with your child to let us know where you'd like to sit (for example, front row, back row, raised seating) - if the seats you want have sold, we will make sure you get the next best available seats.

For those who haven't been before, there are flat rows of seats at the front on the floor, the rest are raised on tiered seating. If you need wheelchair access, just let us know. Payment can be made by cheque (payable to PHGS), cash (correct amount, if possible!) or through scopy (in advance of purchase).

Every year, the cast, band and crew here at Prince Henry's Grammar School astound the audience with the breadth of talent both on and off stage. If you dreamed a dream in time gone by, somewhere beyond the barricade there is a world you long to see, when tomorrow comes....
