**RE: PARENTS' GCSE REVISION STRATEGY EVENING – Thursday 13th November

As part of the strategy for preparing your child for the GCSE Examination period this year, we have identified some key revision strategies which you may find useful when assisting them with revision.

We warmly invite you, as a parent/carer of a Yr11 student, to school on **Thursday 13th November** from 6.30pm in Lower Hall. Our aim will be to give you a complete guide through five tried-and-tested strategies which you can use at home with your child. The evening will consist of a brief introduction followed by five separate strategy sessions, each lasting approximately ten minutes:

Teacher	Role in school	Strategy
Mrs Thomas	Teacher of History	<i>'Making revision stick'</i>
Mr Fox	Teacher of Mathematics	<i>How to create visual revision notes: mind maps / revision cards / sequencing</i>
Mrs Wakelin	Area Leader: PHSE & Citizenship	<i>How to summarise all of those revision notes</i>
Mrs Kapoor	Area Leader: Chemistry	<i>Using technology to revise</i>
Mrs Sadler	Teacher of Art	<i>Simple and Effective Revision</i>

It is hoped that you will gain valuable insight into how we encourage our students to revise and that one, or most, of these revision techniques will be useful when helping your son/daughter prepare for trial examinations in December and GCSE examinations in May/June.

The event will begin at 6.30pm and should not finish later than 8.00pm.
