Dear Parent / Carer

Congratulations on securing a place at Prince Henry's Grammar School. We are writing to inform you about our Year 7 induction programme. It is designed to support students as they transfer to a much larger school.

We aim to provide parents with essential information to help them support their child and also give new students the opportunity to meet each other and spend some time in school. Key staff will spend time with our primary schools in order to learn as much as they can about our new students and their individual needs. The schedule is as follows:

Visits to Primary Schools throughout the Summer Term:

- Mr Day, Director of Key Stage 3 and Mrs McQuire, Year 7 Manager, will visit feeder schools to help introduce the students to life at Prince Henry's Grammar School
- Mrs Hunter, SENCO, and members of the SEND team will visit feeder schools to talk to teachers and staff about individual needs.

Family Information Pack, Admissions Forms and Family Survey – April/May 2026

- An online information pack including key details about uniform, school dinners and so on will be released to parents in late April. A link to the online Admissions Form will also be supplied. This would also include a Family Survey that we would ask parents to complete about experiences at primary school and any concerns about the move to secondary school. There will be opportunities to meet with the Key Stage 3 team during the summer term.

Year 6 Induction Days – Wednesday 8th to Friday 10th July 2026

- Students are invited to spend three days at Prince Henry's. They will sample lessons and have lunch in the cafeteria. The days will begin at 8.45am and end at 2.45pm.

Year 6 New Parents' Evening – scheduled for Thursday 9th July 2026, 6.00pm

- Following the first Induction Days, parents are invited to a New Parents' Evening where they will learn important information about their child's transfer to Prince Henry's Grammar School.
