### Non-uniform Day – Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2026

In response to a request from our Senior Students, we have agreed to hold a non-uniform day next week on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April, which is the last day of this term. Non-uniform day enables all students to show their support for their chosen charities, which for 2025-2026 are the national charity Endometriosis UK (selected by the Student Council) and the Otley-based charity The Sarah Jackson Community Wish (chosen by Year 7 students).

We are recommending that students wishing to take part in non-uniform day make a minimum contribution of **£2.00**. Wherever possible, we would request that you kindly use the online payment system (SCOPAY) to make your donation.
