Re: Provision for Critical Workers students from 8th March

The Essential Information for Parents booklet, sent to you today, provides full details of the arrangements for next week's staggered return to school. This letter is to inform you that our provision for the vulnerable and children of critical worker students will continue next week with a few amendments. These are outlined below:

From Monday 8th March students will register at the start of a day in a new location:

Year 7	Main Hall
Year 8	Lower Hall
Year 9	SC5
Year 10	LC8
Year 11	HU3
6 th Form	Library

Once students have registered, they should go to the classrooms they would usually go to for their timetabled lessons. For each lesson they will continue to access remote learning under supervision of their usual class teacher. Students should continue to bring their iPad charger, headphones and a reading book each day (along with the usual equipment) until their year group returns to face-to-face teaching.

As you are already aware, there will be a staggered return to face-to-face teaching from Tuesday 9th March. Once your child's year group returns to face-to-face teaching then they should register in the Form Room that they used in the autumn term. This means that:

Year 10, 12 and 13 return to normal registration on Tuesday 9th March
Year 8 and 11 return to normal registration on Wednesday 10th March
Year 7 and 9 return to normal registration on Thursday 11th March.

On Monday 8th March the current three buses will operate, but from Tuesday 9th March the normal full bus service will resume.

From Wednesday 10th March the previously used break and lunch areas for specific bubbles will be reinstated (meaning Year 9 will follow Year 7 into Henry's at lunch time)

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the students for their hard work and co-operation during the past 8 weeks - I look forward to seeing them re-join their peers.
