Dear Parent/Carer,

Enrichment Sports/Events

Competitive sport is a key part of life at Prince Henry's, and we're proud of the wide range of opportunities and successes our students enjoy. To support this, the school funds over **£30,000 in travel** and other costs (memberships, facility hire, entry) each year.

To help sustain this, we ask parents of students involved in **competitive enrichment sports** to consider making a **voluntary annual contribution**:

- **£30** for boys playing rugby (due to increased fixtures/travel)
- **£20** for all other competitive sports
- **50% of the above** if your child receives free school meals

Payments can be made via SCOPAY or by sending cash/cheque (payable to Prince Henry's Grammar School) in a clearly labelled envelope to the Finance Office. Most travel is by school minibus or Shipley Mini Coaches (01274 532555).

Following a recent review, we've updated our protocols for attending **sporting fixtures during the school day** to ensure events run smoothly and safely.

Please note the following:

- **No videos or photos should be taken at any point.**
- Please support the **participants (and officials)** in a positive and respectful manner.
- **Sign in** at **Main Reception** and a **lanyard** will be issued and must be worn at all times.
- A staff member will **escort you to the fixture** at kick-off time.
- **Arrival:** Please arrive **no more than 30 minutes before kick-off** (details via Squad InTouch). Late arrivals may not be admitted.
- **Entry:** Use the **main entrance on Newall Carr Road** only.
- During the fixture, remain in the **designated area**.
- If the fixture ends **after 3:00 PM**, you may leave independently after signing out.
- **No animals** are allowed on site unless previously arranged with valid reason.
- When collecting students after fixtures, please use marked bays or collect from **Farnley Lane/Newall Carr Road** if no bays are available.

We're extremely proud of our students' sporting participation and success and value your support in following these guidelines. Thank you for your cooperation.
