Leeds DVA Notification Process

Leeds Joint Agency Protocol for Domestic Violence and Abuse: School Notifications (DVA Notifications Process) has been established to support children who live in households where there are incidents of domestic violence and abuse. We know that children can be physically or emotionally harmed by being either present in the house at the time of the incident or directly witnessing an incident of domestic violence.

The DVA Notification Process has been designed to provide confidential notification to schools regarding any incidents of domestic violence and abuse which occur within a child's household that might have an impact on a child whilst they are in school.

The process means that a DVA notification will come through to school and a member of the safeguarding team at Prince Henry's Grammar School. This person will act in confidence to ensure that we as a school are supporting the child/children in their education and making provision for possible difficulties experienced by the incident.

We are keen to NOT cause alarm by this letter, but we do have to share this process with you all.
